aster is upon us, and the joy of the empty tomb and the promise of Spring is in the air. Hundreds will flock to Christ UMC for our Easter services at the beach and the church.

Even with all the joy, another church shooting tops the headlines, this time from Houston, TX. It was a senseless act of violence that left dead and injured in a place that should be immune from such violence. Sadly, houses of worship are not.

Holy Week culminating on Easter Sunday will draw the largest crowds to Christ UMC since Christmas. Your Security Task Team will again do our best to make CUMC a least likely target.

You might be thinking the Mega Church in Houston was more likely to be targeted by a person with a gun. Uvalde, TX, where a gunman entered an elementary school and killed students and faculty, was a town of just over 15,000. The communities that our members come from total over 60,000 beach residents, not counting Jacksonville.

The Security Task Team will ensure doors are locked on campus and screen people entering the church. Neptune Beach Police are on high alert for the 5 churches in our beach town. NB Police will also monitor our beach service that draws up to 600 on a fair weather Easter. They will also oversee the collection.
